Sun exposure:

- P-Prairie: Full or at least half day sun
- S-Savanna: Partially shaded, between trees
- W-Woodland: Heavily shaded / filtered light

Soil conditions:

- W-Wet (soggy or marshy most of the year)
- M-Mesic (medium moist-average soil)
- D-Dry (excessively drained, sandy soil)
